Incredible Invention

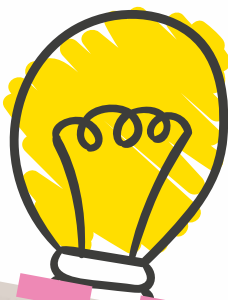
P.5 students have used their imaginations to think of incredible new inventions.

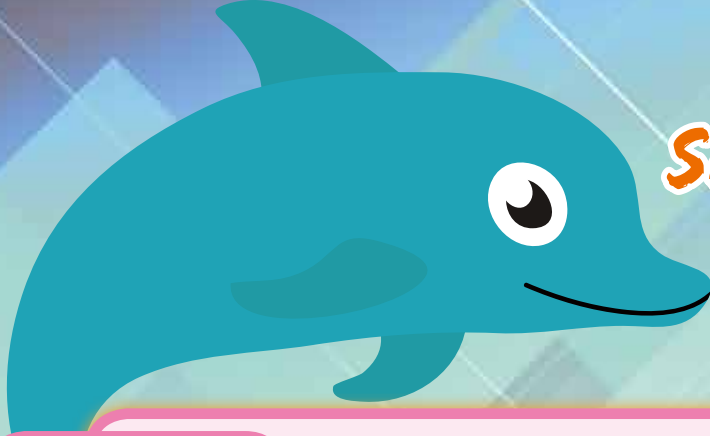
